# LITTLE "ARIE" NEEDS YOUR HELP!!!



Recently Heavensent rescue was contacted by a family to surrender their four month old puppy named Arie. Arie was being walked down a flight of steps by a toddler and she fell and broke her leg in three places. The family took her to their Vet on the day of the fall and were told she needed extensive surgery. The family opted to skip the surgery and take Arie home. Three days later they called Heavensent Bulldog Rescue to surrender Arie. A volunteer from HSBR picked Arie up from the family and immediately took her to the Vet where she will undergo major surgery requiring an implant and pins. The surgery is estimated to cost \$3,000. Arie is only 4 months old and perfectly healthy otherwise. She is expected to make a full recovery and live a healthy life. ## "Mimi & Bubba"

#### Why don't you just get a puppy?

We were asked that question a lot after our Bulldog Duncan died in October. Sure, they're cute...all Bulldogs are! But my husband John had other things in mind. Rescue, he said, and he had apparently already researched the subject and had donated to a locally run rescue in memory of our two Bulldogs: HeavenSent Bulldog Rescue. Bulldogs of all ages, some surrendered, some abandoned, strayed, medical problems, you name it, they find a home for them. I'm in! Application process behind us, we were happily on our way to providing a bulldog who needed us and a forever home.

Bubba came first, our big boy! Love at first sight and soon he was all ours! Bubba had been surrendered with a painful case of bladder stones. Poor guy had just had surgery, but even with all he had been through he settled right in. We were hooked! Who needs a puppy? Thanks to HeavenSent we have this great 78lb Bulldog who needs us as much as we need him! NEXT?!?! A brother or sister for Bubba and he'd get to choose.

A few weeks later we got a phone call from HeavenSent. Charles needed a foster home so he wouldn't have to go to a kennel after he was neutered that day. Could we do it? Yes! And off we went to meet with a HeavenSent volunteer to pick him up. We brought Charles home and hoped that he and our Bubba would hit it off, but unfortunately that didn't happen. Bubba is a couch potato and Charles is bouncy and playful. Happily, HeavenSent found Charles a wonderful loving home where he can play and be with other, more playful Bulldogs.

We weren't through trying yet! Maybe Bubba would rather have a sister? In a few days we got a call about Mimi. Mimi had quite a story! She was in Reading, PA., where she was receiving physical therapy to help her learn to walk again. Mimi came to HeavenSent from Louisiana where she had spent most of her life in a crate. She suffered from untreated meningitis that left her neurologically impaired. Mimi may not be physically strong like most Bulldogs, but this sweet little dog's spirit is indomitable. Bubba instantly accepted her and soon we were heading home with our newest family member. In the short time we have had her, she has gone from a quiet, sleepy little dog to a playful, sometimes noisy dog who never misses a chance for a kiss or a cookie. Mimi fits right in.

It is amazing how these dogs change your life for the better. Even with all they have been through, we are inspired by their unconditional love.


